West Virginia State Community and Technical College is seeking applications and/or nominations for a full-time nine-month, renewable term appointment in Biology, effective August 2008. The faculty member will teach both traditional classroom and virtual laboratory components of Human Anatomy & Physiology I & II to Nursing and Allied Health students.

Responsibilities include teaching 15 credit hours per semester (or the equivalent) in workforce development, fast track, non-credit instruction or other assignments. Teaching assignments may include evenings, weekends and off-campus locations. Expectations include service to students, professional development and service to the institution and community.

Qualifications include a master's degree with at least 18-semester hours of graduate credit from a recognized regionally accredited college or university in Science or an Allied Health field. The ability to conduct a virtual clinical lab is required. Successful college level teaching is preferred, as well as an aptitude for using technology in instructional delivery and a willingness to deliver courses online. Demonstration of teaching effectiveness is part of the on-campus interview.

Salary and rank are commensurate with education and experience.
